



Apostle Highlands is not overly difficult. It is playable for most every golfer



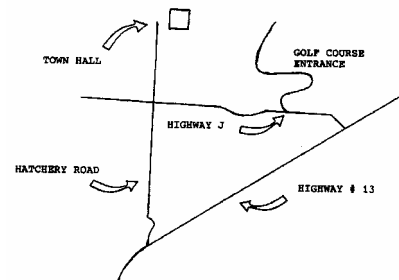

Located 500 feet above Lake Superior’s south shore, Apostle Highlands offers a variety of fantastic views of Chequamegon Bay and the Apostle Islands, including the rugged shoreline, all the way to upper Michigan.



Hole number one is our “Signature Hole” and has players teeing off across a small-scale replica of Lake Superior, complete with a lighthouse on “Isle Royale”. A successful drive gives bragging rights – you can claim to have driven your ball across Lake Superior



Our third hole is known as the most photographed hole. The view of Madeline Island is something to be seen, too beautiful for words and better in person than in a picture.
